Owasco Watershed Rules and Regulations State-Local Technical Workgroup Report

For OLWMC Monthly Meeting: August 16, 2022

General Update:

The technical workgroup worked successfully and efficiently to revise the Storage of Petroleum, Chloride Salt and Coal provision of the proposed regulations. Several provisions will need minor revisions but there were no major changes to the proposed regulations in this section.

Summary of 8/2/2022 Meeting: Storage of Petroleum, Chloride Salt & Coal Reviewed provisions in each bucket:

- 1. Straightforward and not contradictory to other regulations:
 - 1(a)(iii) Bulk Storage- facility inventory records/previous leak detection reports
 - 1(b)(ii) Non-Bulk Storage- underground storage tanks prohibited 100 ft from Owasco Lake & floodplains.
- 2. Need additional detail and clarification
 - 1(a)(ii)- Bulk Storage inventory monitoring records- typically confidential business information. NYSDEC Environmental Conservation Law Part 613 covers both above and underground tanks.
 - 1(a)(iv) Bulk Storage- minor language change.
- 3. Contradictory to state regulations or programs and require further examination
 - 1(b)(I) Non-Bulk Storage- needs to refer to Navigation Law instead of NYSDEC Environmental Conservation Law Part 613. Revisions will include criteria for reporting exemptions.
 - 2(a) Chloride Salt: Revised definition of Chloride Salt.
