WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1411 of the Not-for-Profit Corporation Law ("N-PCL", and hereinafter referred to as the "Act"), and a Certificate of Incorporation (the "Certificate") filed with the New York Secretary of State on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of February, 2011, the Owasco Lake Watershed Management Council, Inc. (the "Corporation") has been established as a not-for-profit, local development corporation to relieve and reduce unemployment, promote and provide for additional and maximum employment, improve and maintain job opportunities, instructing or training individuals to improve or develop their capabilities for such jobs, carrying on scientific research for the purpose of aiding a community or geographical area by attracting new industry to the community or area or by encouraging the development of, or retention of, an industry in the community or area, lessening the burdens of government and acting in the public interest, including undertaking programs and activities in furtherance of managing, monitoring and protecting the water resources of Owasco Lake and the water resources within the Owasco Lake Watershed for the well-being and benefit of the residents of the County; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Dryden, in a Resolution passed by the Town Board of Dryden on February 15, 2022, has declared its intent to become a Director of the Corporation and authorized and appointed Conservation Board Representative, Anne Clark, to represent the Town of Dryden as a Director of the Corporation; and

WHEREAS, the By-Laws of the Corporation pursuant to Article III, Sections 2 and 4, allow that the size of the Board of Directors may be increased and newly created directorships may be filled by approval of the Members;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Members of the Corporation that the Board of Directors of the Corporation is increased from twelve (12) to thirteen (13) Directors, and that the newly created directorship is filled by the Town of Dryden represented by Anne Clark of the Town of Dryden.
